

Dear Families,

We offer two ways that high school students can take Wilmington University courses.

- 1. <u>Dual Enrollment</u> These courses are offered to students at their high school during normal school hours. Credits earned by Dual Enrollment students count as both college credit and toward high school graduation requirements.
- 2. <u>Non-dual enrollment (Early College Program)</u> These courses are offered at WilmU locations and online at a reduced tuition to students.

## For courses offered at High School Partnership Locations; Dual Enrollment, (please initial)

- My child understands that these classes <u>are actual college</u> courses and the amount of time and effort both in and out of class should reflect as such.
- I certify that my student meets the requirements for Dual Enrollment as agreed by the partnership High School and WilmU.
- I understand that my child's WilmU course must be recorded on his/her High School Schedule.
- I understand that I will be responsible for any fees that may be charged by the partnership High School.
- I understand and agree to abide by the important dates such as those for dropping the class, purchasing materials, and completing requirements as set forth by the partnership High School.

## For courses offered at WilmU Locations or online; Non-Dual Enrollment, (please initial)

- My child understands that these classes <u>are actual college</u> courses and the amount of time and effort both in and out of class should reflect as such.
- I understand that my child will need transportation to all face-to-face courses.
- I certify that my student meets the required minimum 2.7 GPA and Junior/Senior status as required by WilmU.
- I understand and agree to abide by the important dates such as those for dropping the class, purchasing materials, and completing requirements as set forth by WilmU.
- I understand that in order to be successful in the class my student should be present at the scheduled class meeting times, which may include either block (7 weeks), semester (14 weeks), or online formats. I also understand that there could be approximately 5-10 hours per week of additional coursework outside of the classroom.
- I understand that I will be responsible for the following items: Course Registration Fee (\$25), Course cost (\$32 per credit), and any books or materials.
- I understand that my student will only earn college credit for these courses. High School credit toward graduation is not guaranteed by WilmU.
